Sl. No.	The school is directed to ensure that:
1	The total number of sections of Bal Vatika shall be restricted to 09 (03 sections each in Bal Vatika I, II & III respectively). The total number of sections of the school from class I to 12th shall be restricted to 56 only of which not more than 1/3rd sections may be used for senior secondary classes. The optimum number of the students shall be restricted to 40 in each section. Further, increase of sections shall strictly be subject to specific approval of the Board on the basis of the request of the school as per affiliation by law and availability of class rooms of greater than 500 sq ft dimension.
2	The school should obtain the proepr NOC and recognition certificate issued by the competent authority of Ministry/Education Department of the state Govt. school has showed the NOC and recognition issued by the DeO which is not competent authority. The proepr certificates should be uploaded on SARAS portal within 03 months.
3	The Building safety certificate is issued by the Pvt Engineer and not by the Govt engineer as required by appendix XI of circular no 12/2022. School is required to obtain the Building safety certificate form the Govt engineer not below the rank of Asstt engineer and upload the certificate in suggestive format with all building details and particular of the issuing authority on SARAS portal within 03 months.
4	All the three science labs for senior secondary level (Physics, Chemistry and Biology) be arranged and equipped with recommended infrastructure on seating arrangements, locked storage of chemicals/solutions, safety arrangements like fire extinguishers, exhaust fans, safe gas fitting for heating facility, safe electric connection and safety manual for users etc as per Board guidelines. School should follow the Sops and guidelines as notified vide circular no 112/022 and upgrade the labs and upload the compliance with video link within 03 months on SARAS portal.
5	The Composite science lab for secondary level should be arranged separately with proper stock, safety measures and work stations as per Board guidelines vide circular no 11/2022 and the compliance with video link be uploaded on SAAS portal within 03 months.
6	The Library is under stocked and is not arranged properly for library operation as per Board guidelines. School has only 4128 books for 1945 students whereas there should be at least 5 books per child (Above 300 students) as per recommended infrastructure notified vide circular no 11/2022 (SoPs on library . labs and sports). More books on recreational and motivational materials, encyclopaedia, children's magazines, stories, maps and charts etc with infrastructure on Information Communication Technology Infrastructure for e-learning resources to be added. Further, the books have also not been arranged and catalogued properly for easy access. School should upgrade the library as per SoPs and upload the compliance on SARAS portal within 03 months.
7	The Computer lab is also under stocked. School has total 65 computer nods in three labs for around 1945 students in 57 sections. There should be minimum 01 computer for 20 students (above 800 students) as per Board guidelines notified vide circular no 11/2022. School should upgrade the computer lab as per Board guidelines with all required infrastructure and upload the compliance on SARAS portal within 03 months.
8	As reported by the IC, school has not arranged the required safety measures in the school. There are only 10 fire extinguishers in the secondary block and 06 in junior wing for around 2000 students. The fire extinguishers and other equipment including water sprinklers etc should be properly in working conditions with validity. School should have proper safety equipment, clean toilets and washrooms and proper CCTV surveillance as per affiliation bye laws and the safety guidelines issued by the NCPCR. The compliance be uploaded within 03 months on SARAS portal.

9	As per school information and verified by the IC, school has only four CwSN toilets (02 each for boys and girls). School building is G+3 Floors with 57 running sections for around 2000 students and only four CwSN toilets are not sufficient. There should be separate CwSN toilets for boys and girls at each floor with recommended infrastructure and facilities as per Bord guidelines vide circular no 05/2023. School should arrange the toilets for CwSN including ramp/lift to access the upper floors in all building blocks and upload the compliance with video link within 03 months on SARAS portal.
10	School has not constituted the POCSO committee and the constitution of the sexual harassment at work place committee is also not as per the statutory provisions of the law/act. School is directed to constitute the proepr committees as per directions/mandate of the law and upload the compliance on SARAS portal within 03 months.
11	The school shall conduct training of its teachers with CoE Vijayawada, CBSE and submit the compliance on SARAS portal within 03 months .

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII, as the case may be.

The above sanction is subject to fulfillment of following conditions:-

- The approval is based upon the documents /data/information uploaded by the school online. The school will be responsible
 for its genuineness. In case of any discrepancies, necessary action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye Laws-2018.
- 2. The school will follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
- 3. The School is required to apply on online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
- 4. The school should go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy there of for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., http://cbseacademic.nic.in/ & http://cbse.nic.in/ for updates.
- 5. The school is required to renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
- 6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.
- 7. The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.
- 8. The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.

"The school shall possess valid fire safety certificate and Building safety certificate during functioning of the school which shall be renewed from time to time as per norms".

If the compliance is not submitted with in the stipulated 3 months, the Board may enhance the penalty amount and debar the schools from filling up registration/LOC details of students of classes IX to XII, as the case may be, in the next academic session i.e. 2024-25.
