- The school shifted to the new building during 1998.
- The charge of first principal was given to **Dr. Subhash Damle** of CRPF.
- The first regular Principal was **Shri. Mathew Joseph** succeeded by **Shri. Hameed** and now **Smt. D Aparna , Principal** since 2020.
- This was the second endeavor of the society.
- The CRPF Public School, Jawhar Nagar is a Co-educational day-cum residential higher secondary school with an enrollment of **1932** (CRPF wards-868,civil wards – 1064) students from classes UKG to XII.
- The school aims to become a 'Center for Excellence', providing quality education for India's deserving young minds, empowering them to be courageous, confident and self- disciplined.
